“Living a Life of Victory”

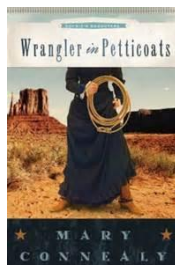

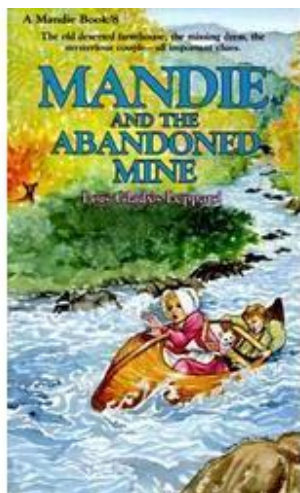

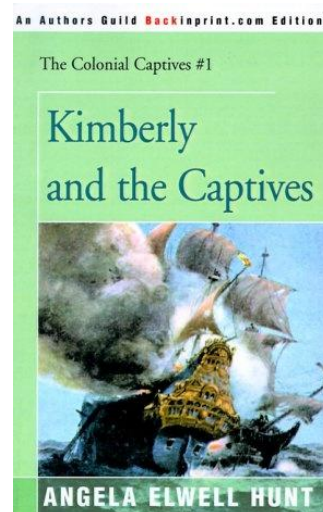

Mandie and the Abandoned Mine by Lois Gladys Leppard is a book for young teens. Uncle John has received an offer to buy his old mine as Rose Creek. But he promises not to sell it until Mandie and her friend Joe have had a chance to see it. Exploring a deserted farmhouse near the mine, they discover a fancy new dress hanging on the wall. Returning the next day, the dress is gone! What will Mandie and Joe find during their next exploration of the mine? Their next trip to the mine finds the entrance boarded up. Caught in the intrigue, Joe and Mandie disobey her mother's warnings and fall prey to great danger!

Kimberly and the Captives by Angela Elwell Hunt is an adult fiction book. In 1627 a shipload of children makes its way to the colony of Jamestown. The children are not passengers, but cargo to be sold into servitude. Only two people aren't destined for this sad fate – Kimberly Hollis and her mother, who are sailing to America to join Kimberly's father. The voyage won't be easy – not only is the main hold dirty and crowded with homeless children, but the crew of the ship will have to battle a fierce storm and a priate seeking revenge.
