Hi Everyone! I want to thank everyone for giving toward both the Summer Mission trip to Grundy Mountain Mission, and for their fire relief. Your generosity was greatly appreciated! Hopefully you received the phone tree call this week indicating we are no longer collecting funds for either of these needs.

Recently you received a warning about being careful as you walk through the alley behind our building. We are experiencing erosional and weathering issues from above our third floor windows which has caused falling debris. Please continue to be advised about this issue. As an FYI, we had a company give us an estimate to fix these 8 sandstones. Their quote was almost \$32,000, and that does not cover additional cost with the city, etc.... Let me remind everyone that this is about \$4,000 more than what it cost to put a new roof on our building a few years ago. Obviously, the Facility Management Committee will continue to search for other quotes to rectify the building repair. This is just another reminder why we are forging ahead with plans to relocate to our Sheridan Road property.

Speaking of which, our Vision Team met this past Monday night to continue planning and dreaming about what this building could look like. Soon you will be given a chance to have input regarding this future building. We will keep you informed as to when that will be. We covet your prayers and ask that you specifically pray for God's Will to be done in all planning.

April 29th- Looking ahead to the last Sunday of the month, we will have our Sunday evening gathering in the Fellowship Hall. This month, we will meet from 5:30-7:30 p.m. due to the length of our Christian film. Please make a note of this time change. If you plan to attend, you are asked to bring a snack for all to enjoy.
