CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

There will be a special congregational meeting on Sunday, March 17th, for a Proposed Change to the By-Laws of the Fifth Avenue Church of Christ.

Current By-Law:

Article II: The Membership

2. Amended February 2018: Every active member (as described in Article III, Section 4) shall have the right to vote in all congregational decisions as outlined in these by-laws.

Proposed Change:

Every active member (as described in Article III, Section 4) **having obtained the age of 18** shall have the right to vote in all congregational decisions as outlined in these by-laws.
