Here are directions from our current building...

- Continue on Rainbow Drive until you turn left onto Sheridan Drive (Old Millersport Road)
- Turn left on Ludwig Court.
- Turn right on Hawk Street. Our property begins when your tires hit the grass.

Alternative directions from the church building...

- Take Fifth Avenue to North High Street and turn left.
- Continue on North High Street until Fair Avenue and turn right.
- Continue on Fair Avenue until it dead ends at Sheridan Drive. Go left onto Sheridan Drive.
- Stay on Sheridan until you come to Rainbow Drive. Turn right.
- Take the first left back onto Sheridan Drive,
- Turn left onto Ludwig Court.
- Turn right on Hawk Street. Our property begins when your tires hit the grass.
