

THOUGHTS FROM BRAD ...

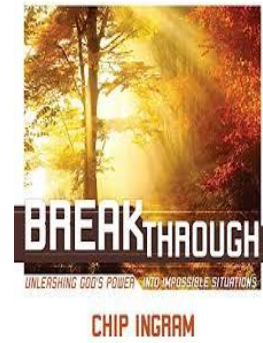
Sept. 1st- There will be **no evening service tonight!** I hope you have a great holiday weekend with your family and friends.

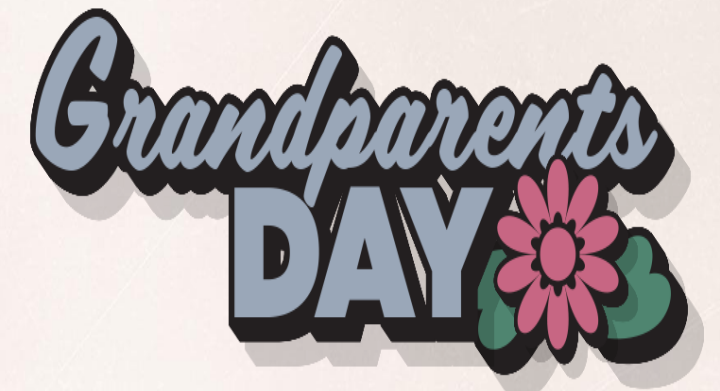
