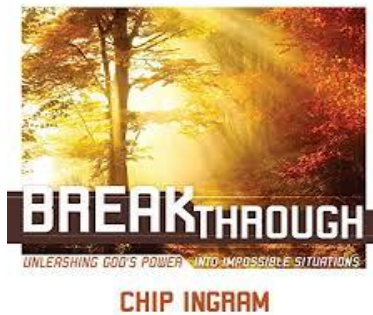


## THOUGHTS FROM BRAD ...

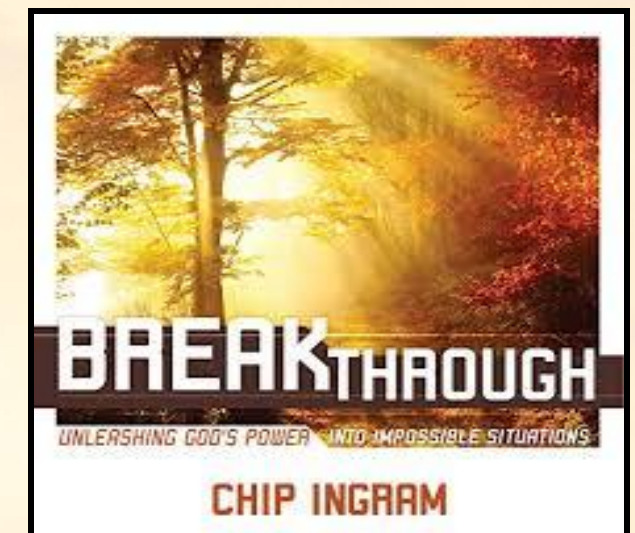
