

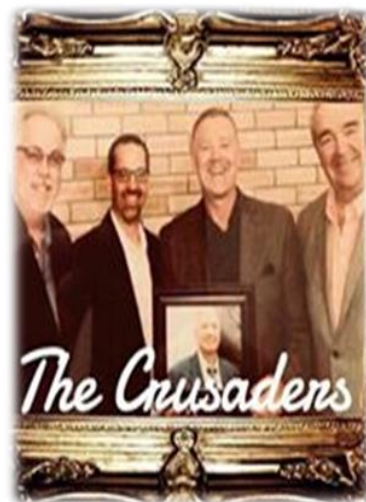
THOUGHTS FROM BRAD ...

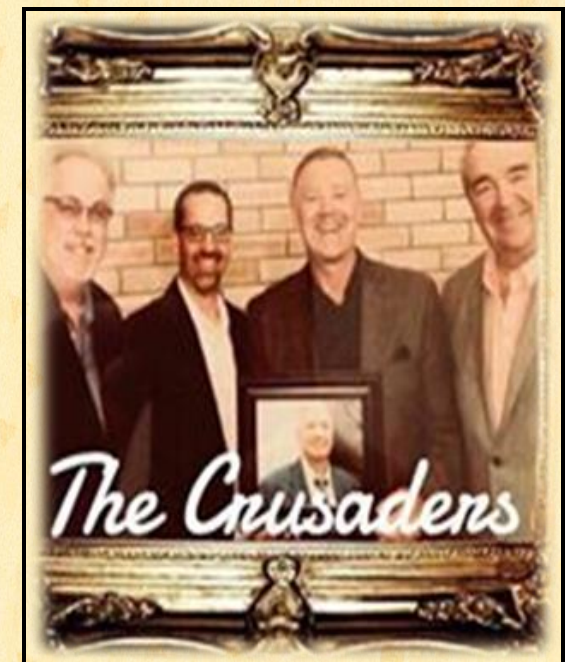
