Attention Men! Our trip to the Bean Dinner has been canceled.

Today, we have provided an insert with the bulletin which lays out our plan for any future activities or events as a church while the current virus threat is prevalent. The Leadership team and myself will keep you apprised of when we will lift any restrictions for building usage as we seek to keep all attendees safe. We are taking extra precautions to keep the building as germ-free as possible. We ask for your compliance to our decisions and your patience during this period of time. I am also including this information in my article for those who have access to the newsletter on the internet but are currently unable to attend due to illness.

Until further notice, we are suspending the following...

- Sunday School for children and adults;
- Children's Church during Worship; children will worship in sanctuary;
- All other church functions: 3F luncheons, monthly fellowship meals, music practices, special events you may have planned here, such as birthday or anniversary parties or other large group activities, any children and youth activities, music practices, meetings, etc...basically any function outside of our regular worship hours and Wednesday night Bible study. Please do not plan any activity for the building. We have also suspended visitation on any who are in hospital or ill at home; this includes the suspension of delivering home communion.
- We seek to comply with the Governor's plan, and will keep worshipping together and doing Bible study as usual, until we are advised not to.

Today we have made available a packet of information for our future building project. Please take it with you and peruse if you have not already received a copy. We have two **identical** meetings in the future to answer ANY QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE. **The remaining two meetings are intended for those who have yet to participate due to their schedules.** Please, if you have already attended the first meeting, do not come to the others so we can help keep the risk down for illness!
